ADVOCACY

- ★ The June revenue forecast was released on Friday, June 18. State revenues have been growing more strongly than forecasted in March the growth has been so strong that TABOR refunds will be required for the 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23 budget years. - ★ Delegate Assembly the <u>call for resolutions</u> is now open and the deadline for submission this year is Friday, August 30th. There is a <u>guidance document that</u> provides additional information on the process.
