- <u>Prezi:</u> This is full of great slide templates and Prezi gives you the ability to create
 presentations with a wow factor. You can also interact on video with your
 presentations in real time.
- <u>Emaze:</u> This enables you to create elaborate mixed-media slides. You also have the ability to import PowerPoint presentations into Emaze and upgrade them with new content.
- <u>Powtoon:</u> This visual communication platform gives you the ability to create professional and fully customized videos as well as animated presentations.
