CASB Launches Boardsmanship Basics for School Board Candidates

Candidates are campaigning for seats on their local school boards, and in an effort to help candidates understand some of the complexities of being a school board member, CASB is offering for <u>no cost</u> the first course in the Boardsmanship series. Candidates running for school board and new board members who will be seated in an uncontested election can access the first course by registering at www.learn.casb.org.

Course One, "Welcome to Board Service" is a 30-minute introduction to school board service by CASB Deputy Executive Direction, Leslie Bogar, and the video provides an overview of the work of a school board and some valuable insights about getting up to speed as a newly elected school board member.
