The Colorado Supreme Court recently issued a significant opinion on the details of the Open Meetings Law, regarding whether a board can address a mistake under the Open Meetings Law by "curing" the error in a subsequent meeting. "Curing" an open meetings law violation refers to the practice of holding a complying meeting after a violation that confirms the prior action, retroactive to the first meeting.

The Court ruled that curing an open meetings violation is permitted under the Open Meetings Law, but also ruled that curing a violation does not necessarily eliminate liability for school districts related to the original violation.
